

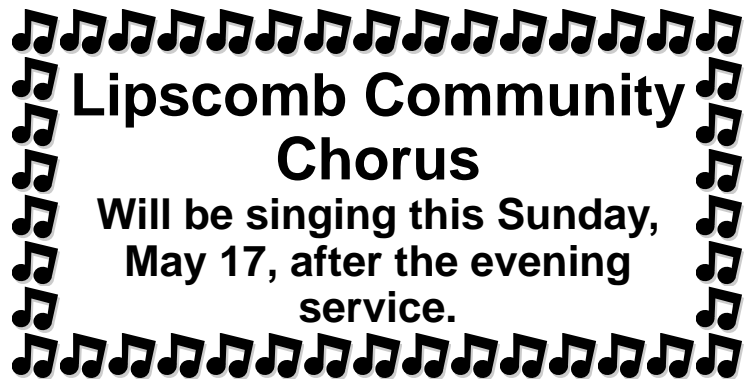

Just Be Sincere

To the untrained eye, all three bottles appear to be the same...all are liquids and all are colorless. But a sincere person, mistaking the sulfuric acid for water, is no less dead than another person who drank the acid intentionally. One was sincerely wrong, but both are sincerely dead!
