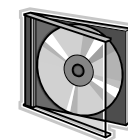

How Do You Spell Love?


