

# God and a Jaw Bone

Judges 15:12-17

## Introduction

- As we have seen in past studies, Samson was called upon by God to walk and act in a way different from those around Him. Even before he was born, he was appointed by God to be a Nazarite. For much of Samson's life he fell far short of his calling. His life in summary is the story of what could have been.
- In the scripture before us we have one of the bright spots in a life otherwise marked by dark blots. This is one occasion where we must complement Samson for his actions.
- In verse 14 we read of how “the Spirit of LORD came mightily upon him”; I want to build my thoughts around this statement and glean three lessons that are associated with a Spirit-filled life. First, think with me of:
